LTOS248/2008 **DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST**

LTOS250/2008 **DAFFODIL BULBS – MINUTE NO: 117/2008 REFERS:**

RECOMMENDED that the Council purchases daffodil bulbs for the Girl Guides to plant.

RECOMMENDED that the Clerk determined whether there were two sets of goal posts and that a funding reserve remained in the budget should further posts require replacement.

NOTED the report from the Clerk that a response from TaWRA concerning suitable play sites was awaited.

LAWN PLAY EQUIPMENT PHASE 2 – MINUTE NO: LTOS 201/2008 REFERS:

NOTED the report from the Clerk that two further quotes were required and that the young people were to be consulted through Padstow Youth Forum and the Library in order to meet the funding criteria. **RECOMMENDED** that Padstow Youth Forum be asked whether their grant of £6,000 could be spent on the provision of a temporary youth worker to replace the youth worker on sick leave.

LTOS255/2008

FERRY STEPS – HANDRAIL

RECOMMENDED that Cllr Edwards spoke to Padstow Harbour Commissioners regarding the replacement of the handrail and shared costs.

LTOS256/2008

BENCH – EMPTY PURSE

RECOMMENDED that the Council provided a weather proof seat for 'Empty Purse' from the LGAs 137 budget, the same type as was situated in the Cemetery.

LTOS257/2008

BANDSTAND – REQUEST FOR PERMANENT COVER

RECOMMENDED that the Council did not provide a permanent cover for the bandstand by virtue that it would not be appropriate in an area with seagulls.

LTOS258/2008

STREET ORGAN

RECOMMENDED that the Clerk sought further information and referred the letter writer to PATA Ltd with regard to playing the street organ at the Christmas Festival.

LTOS259/2008

BUDGET 2009/2010

RECOMMENDED the following bid for a budget to be presented to the Finance Staffing & General Purposes Committee on 9 December 2008:

1. £50,000 for exercise/play equipment for 12-19 and over 60 years old – match funding to be applied for.
2. £10,000 per annum for plantation works.
3. £30,000 for Trevone play equipment.
4. £2,500 for new handrail at Ferry Steps.
5. £15,000 for replacement of Cory Shelter roof.
6. £1,000 contingency for football posts.
7. £20,000 for half-pipe.
8. £15,000 for tourism events:
 - (i) Up to £5,000 (or 33%) of Sir John Betjeman/Sir Malcolm Arnold Festival.
 - (ii) £10,000 for Christmas festival and Christmas lights plus the cost of scaffolding IRO £2,000.
9. £10,000 for support of Tourist Information Centre.
10. £6,000 for Padstow Youth Forum.
11. £5,000 contingency reserve for further costs connected with the Unitary Council and associated devolved services.

Total budget bid: £166,500
