- LTOS2015/56      Apologies for absence:** were received from Councillor R Buscombe
- LTOS2015/57      Announcements:** None
- LTOS2015/58      Declarations of Interest:** There were no declarations of interest
- LTOS2015/59      Minutes Tuesday 26 January 2016: RESOLVED** that the minutes of the meeting held on Tuesday 26 January 2016 were a true record of the meeting and they were signed by the chair.
- LTOS2015/60      Clerks Report/ Work Programme:** was noted for information.
- LTOS2015/61      Correspondence:** Noted.
- LTOS2015/62      Updates:**
- a) Churchyard Cremation Plots:** The update was noted. **RESOLVED** that the Town Clerk i) speak with Father Chris regarding possible inclusion of a ramp to access the cremation plots; ii) contact the contractor to provide cost in this regard; and iii) clarify with RFO available budget in this regard.
  - b) Signage: Seagulls: RESOLVED** that edge wrapped signs be ordered, as detailed in the agenda paper.
  - c) Hill Steps:** The update was noted. It was hoped Hill Steps would be opened in time for Easter.
  - d) Plantation: Tree:** Update was noted.
- LTOS2015/63      Lawns Play Area and Wheal Jubilee Park Inspections Update:** The update was noted and that remedial/maintenance work required was in hand.
- LTOS2015/64      Play Area – Lawns:** The Town Clerk advised that informally she had been able to speak with leaders of both the Guides and Scouts. Both were on board with proposals to upgrade

their current facilities. Town Clerk commented that she was trying to ascertain detail in respect of the Scout Hut and would continue to do so. It was considered that in order to pursue this idea that confirmation in writing from each group would be helpful.

There was much discussion in this matter. It was felt that any group affected by this scheme who were on the Lawns area be formally invited/advised of the Town Meeting, when this was discussed.

It was considered, that although not budgeted as yet, if a building could be available for Scouts and Guides to share this would be ideal.

The breakdown of costs from Matt Vale of PWH was noted. Clearly whichever project was decided would determine cost.

Committee was keen for any plans to be taken to the Annual Town Meeting. Comment was made that the budget would dictate the scheme however, question be raised as to whether the scheme could be added to later.

**RESOLVED** that the Town Clerk i) write to both the Guides and Scouts seeking their confirmation that they are happy to work with the Council in pursuing a scheme on the Lawns Play Area;  
ii) request that Matt Vale, PWH put forward a design and build scheme for Plan 2 [with Scout hut in situ] as per the budget allocated for both skate facility and MUGA/Tennis Court; and  
iii) to query that if the area was larger if it could be added to at a later date.

**LTOS2015/65** **Conditions Survey:** The Town Clerk had met with Matt Vale of PWH to advise and show him the Council's estate. He would provide cost in undertaking such a survey. This would be reported to a future meeting.
