Minutes of the Extra-Ordinary Meeting of the Leisure, Tourism and Open Space Committee held on Tuesday 21 February 2017 at Council Offices, Unit 5b Treceus Industrial Estate, Padstow commencing at 6.50 pm

LTOS2016/61 Apologies for absence: were received from Councillors F J Bealing and A P Flide

LTOS2016/62 Announcements: There were no announcements.

LTOS2016/63 Declarations of Interest: There were no declarations of interest.

LTOS2016/64 Public Participation: There was no public participation.

LTOS2016/65 Cemetery Improvements:

- a) Cemetery cremation plots: Committee was drawn to the agenda report and plans which had been drafted by Councillor F J Bealing. Overall Committee was pleased with the plans and specification which were similar to the new cremation plots in the Churchyard. Committee acknowledged that the plots currently in place were not being used and welcomed that they would be replaced with this new design. **RESOLVED** that i) Committee approve the plans and specification for new cremation plots in the cemetery; ii) the Town Clerk approach the contractors who were pricing for the other improvement works to undertake the work.
- b) Cemetery Regulations: Committee noted that the new area would require tablet sizes to that in the Churchyard i.e. 15" x 12" with integral vase therefore the Cemetery Regulations would need to be updated. **RESOLVED to recommend to Council** to update paragraph 38 of the Cemetery Regulations, as per the detail outlined in the report.

LTOS2016/66 Skate Park Consultation: Comment was made that overall the consultation event had gone well. A number of young people had attended and they were excited by what was being proposed. The outcome of the consultation was 81 preferred the Bencrete scheme, with only 5 voting for the scheme put forward by Freestyle. In light of the views from the public it was **RESOLVED** that Bencrete was the preferred contractor. Town Clerk to contact the Project Manager to set up an initial meeting.
